# WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT FOR LI FAMILY FUN FESTIVAL, INC.

- 1. In consideration for receiving permission to participate in the event, I hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE, Town of Babylon, Copiague Chamber of Commerce, Nightingale & Nightingale, Inc., LI Family Fun Festival, Inc., their officers, agents, servants, pets, or employees (hereinafter referred to as RELEASEES) from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me or any participants at this event, or any of the property belonging to me or any participants, or any action resulting upon my instruction or my coordination of activities for this event WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES, or otherwise, while participating in such activity, or while in, on or upon the premises where the activity is being conducted.
- 2. I am fully aware of the risks involved and hazards connected with this activity, including but not limited to travel risks and/or possible event accidents. I hereby elect to voluntarily participate in said activity with full knowledge that said activity may be hazardous to me and my property. I VOLUNTARILY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISKS OF LOSS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, that may be sustained by me or any participants, or any loss or damage of property owned by me or participants, as a result of being engaged in such activity, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
- 3. I further hereby AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the RELEASEES from any loss, liability, damage or costs, including court costs and attorney fees, that they may incur due to my participation and coordination of said activity, WHETHER CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES or otherwise.
- 4. It is my express intent that this Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement shall bind the members of my family and partner or spouse, if I am alive, and my heirs, assigns and personal representative, if I am deceased, and shall be deemed as a RELEASE, WAIVER, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the above-named RELEASEES. I hereby further agree that this Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York.
- 5. IN SIGNING THIS RELEASE, I ACKNOWLEDGE AND REPRESENT THAT I have read the foregoing Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed; no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written agreement, have been made; I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent; and I execute this Release for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by same.
- 6. The Long Island Family Fun Festival, Inc. has put preventive measures in place due to the spread of COVID-19 or other communicable diseases. However, attending an event could increase the risk of contracting the coronavirus or any other communicable disease. By participating in this event, I voluntarily assume all risk and agree that I will not hold the RELEASEES liable for any resulting illness, injury or death. If such injury or death results from the inherent risks of contracting COVID-19 or other communicable diseases, I am assuming this risk by agreeing to participate in this event.

### COVID-19 (and Other Communicable Diseases) Guidelines: Vendor Agreement and Acknowledgement

Due to the ongoing threat of COVID-19 and other communicable diseases, all Long Island Family Festival Vendors will be required to agree to the following policies and guidelines. Please sign below where indicated.

#### LONG ISLAND FAMILY FESTIVAL COVID-19 AND OTHER COMMUNICABLE DISEASES VENDOR POLICIES

By signing this document, you are agreeing to the items below: Vendors who violate these policies will forfeit their vendor fee for noncompliance of the Festival COVID 19/Communicable Diseases Guidelines and will not be accepted as a vendor at the 2026 Long Island Family Festival until after the regular application period has closed if space allows.

- Vendor understands that the festival's location in Tanner Park is a public park. It is possible that people visiting the
  festival have been exposed to and/or have been diagnosed with one or more communicable diseases including but not
  limited to COVID-19 or other diseases or maladies. It is impossible to eliminate the risk that vendor, or other occupants,
  might be exposed to and/or become infected through presence in the festival or participation in festival related
  activities. The undersigned understands the risk and expressly assumes responsibility for said risk.
- Vendor will require all employees/volunteers within their vendor booth to follow Local Town, State and National COVID
  or communicable disease guidelines and mandates.
- Vendor will make hand sanitizer available when possible, in a visible location for festival attendee use at their booths.
- Vendor will make every effort to provide contactless payment options for festival attendees when possible.
- Vendor will require all booth employees/volunteers to monitor their health and will not allow an employee or volunteer
  to work at their booth if they are exhibiting any COVID-19 or other communicable disease symptoms to include, but not
  limited to: fever, shortness of breath, active cough, runny nose, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell.
- Vendor agrees to report any sudden onset of COVID-19 or any other communicable disease symptoms in their employees/volunteers to include fever, shortness of breath, active cough, runny nose, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell during festival hours to a festival representative for further guidance. Vendors who experience COVID-19 or other communicable disease symptoms during festival hours will be asked to vacate the festival premises.
- Vendor agrees that vendor, vendor employees/volunteers will not attend the LI Family Festival if they or anyone in their households have tested positive or have come into contact as defined by CDC for COVID-19 or any other communicable diseases during the period of September 1, 2025 through September 12, 2025 (Oct 10-Oct 24 if rain date is used).
- Vendor agrees to report all incidents of an employee or volunteer testing positive for COVID-19 or any other communicable disease within 14 days after the LI Family Festival takes place. Please e-mail <u>alyssa@nightingalepr.com</u> or phone 631-367-8599.
- Vendor agrees to promote and enforce social distancing for customers in line or visitors at their booth.
- Vendor agrees to abide by all applicable NYS, Suffolk County, Town of Babylon and LI Family Festival guidelines while at the Long Island Family Festival and to clean frequently touched surfaces throughout the duration of the festival.
